# **TEA Ends Advanced Technical Credit** (ATC) Statewide Articulation Program


Students will no longer have the opportunity to receive Advanced Technical Credit for approved CTE courses. TEA has discontinued the program for statewide articulation.

## CTE COURSE APPLICATIONS PREVENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR DISCRIMINATION CLAIMS

By federal law, enrollment in all CTE courses must be non-discriminatory. To ensure that this law is met, courses that have more student requests than can be accommodated require a designated student application process based upon the scoring rubric set by the district. Students not accepted immediately must be put on a waitlist and added to the course as seats become available. After school begins, any additional spaces are filled on a 1<sup>st</sup> come/1<sup>st</sup> served basis.
