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CTE COURSE APPLICATIONS PREVENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR DISCRIMINATION CLAIMS

By federal law, enrollment in all CTE courses must be non-discriminatory. To ensure that this law is met, courses that have more student requests than can be accommodated require a designated student application process based upon the scoring rubric set by the district. Students not accepted immediately must be put on a waitlist and added to the course as seats become available. After school begins, any additional spaces are filled on a 1st come/1st served basis.
