
GCCISD GT TESTING CAMPUS PROCESSES

Screener


Students are screened via ISIP and MAP BOY assessments. Students who score 85 or better on the screeners and 90 or higher on teacher evaluations are tested further.



STEP 2

Testing

Students who move forward in the process are assessed via the NNAT 3. Counselors are contacted with student names and testing dates prior to proctor arrival.



STEP 3

Testing

Students who score 85 or better on the NNAT3 may be further assessed via the IOWA assessment. Prior to the proctor's arrival, counselors are contacted with student names and testing dates.



STEP 4

GT Committee Meets

The GT Selection

Committee convenes to review data and determine GT program placement for each student.



STEP 5

Parent Notification

Campuses and parents
are notified of student
qualification or nonqualification with a score
report. Appeals
information is included in
the notification. Appeals
are open for ten days
after notification.



STEP 6

GT Services Begin

Kindergarten GT services begin in January. Referral GT services begin the next school year.
