# GRADING POLICY



**Our choir grading policy follows the district guidelines:**

- **40% Daily Participation**
- **This includes your effort, engagement, responsiveness to feedback, completion of daily assignments, and personal growth. If you are consistently trying your best and staying involved, you will earn a 100 in this category.**
- **60% Tests and Concerts**
- **Tests and performances make up the majority of your grade. Since we only have a few concerts, each one is extremely important.**

**Concert Attendance:**

**Concerts are not just graded events — they are core experiences in our choir program.**

- **If you are unable to attend a concert, you must notify me in advance.**
- **You can make up the grade, but you cannot make up the experience.**

**We want every choir student to participate in every performance. Your presence matters — to your grade, your growth, and your team!**

## REQUIREMENTS

**Because performance is part of our curriculum,  
The “No Pass/No Play” rule does not apply—except for  
competitions and certain special circumstances.**

**However, if you are suspended from school or assigned to an  
alternative placement due to behavior, you may not be allowed  
to attend or participate in any events on school grounds until  
your consequence is completed.**

**Please be mindful of your behavior and the potential  
consequences—it matters!**

# PROCEDURES, RULES, AND EXPECTATIONS

- When you enter the choir room, please place your backpack along the wall under the whiteboard.
- You will have your materials with you every day.
- YOU WILL NEVER CHEW GUM IN THE CHOIR ROOM.
- YOU WILL NOT EAT OR DRINK IN THE CHOIR ROOM. (Water only.)
- YOU WILL FOLLOW THE SCHOOL POLICY FOR CELL PHONES IN THE CHOIR ROOM.
- YOU WILL FOLLOW THE SCHOOL DRESS CODE IN THE CHOIR ROOM.
- You will show yourself, your peers, and your director respect, and you will receive the same respect in return.
- You will participate in all activities fully and with a willingness to learn.
- Students are to remain in their seats unless stated otherwise or they are doing small group work where they have to spread out.
- Only one child may go to the bathroom at a time. They have to use their smart pass.
- NO STUDENTS MAY PLAY THE PIANO WITHOUT ME PRESENCE.

# FIELD TRIP

## REQUIREMENTS

### Off Campus = Privilege



Any time our choir travels off campus, it is a privilege and standards will be met in order to participate. The campus principal may set additional requirements for field trips that must be adhered to.

The director reserves the right to remove students from field trips, evaluations, competitions, if that student has not met the requirements. The director will notify students and parents if this happens.

Money paid in advance for field trips cannot be refunded, per district policy.

1. Student must have no unexcused absences from any required choir events
2. Student must have at least a 90 average in choir class
3. Student must have at least a G in conduct in choir class
4. Student must have no ISS, OSS, or POINT placement in the 6 weeks prior to the field trip.
