<b>What is it?</b>	George Washington Carver Elementary School is committed to the education of the children in our community. We know parent and family engagement is an important component in ensuring that our students are successful. <b>Family Meetings</b>	<p>George Washington Carver Elementary School holds an Annual Title I Meeting the first semester to review Title I school requirements and the Parent and Family Engagement Policy. The Parent and Family Engagement Policy will also be communicated and distributed to each family at our Meet the Teacher Event, Open House Event, and the school website. The policy is presented in both English and Spanish.</p> <p>Information about school and family programs, meetings, and other activities will be shared with parents and families through our monthly newsletters, weekly updates, social media, and our parent/family communication platform.</p>

<b>Family Trainings/ Activities</b>	Family training sessions provide valuable opportunities for families to gain new skills and insights from a variety of sources, including other parents, community members, and educators. Information about the schedule and locations will be shared through our monthly newsletter, weekly updates, social media, and our parent/family communication platform.
<b>Curriculum</b>	George Washington Carver Elementary School utilizes high-quality curriculum that supports student success. Information about our curriculum, forms of assessment used to measure progress, and the proficiency level students are expected to meet will be distributed by the school staff via flyers, parent-teacher conferences, meetings, and newsletters.
<b>Forms of Academic Assessments</b>	<p>At George Washington Carver Elementary School, all teachers administer common formative assessments. Regardless of the teacher, every student is assessed using the same assessment provided by the TEKS Resource System, which aligns with the format of the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) test.</p> <p>In addition to state accountability tests, released STAAR tests are utilized for both assessment and instruction. These tests are essential for evaluating student performance and informing instructional decisions.</p> <p>Test information, including TELPAS and STAAR results, will be shared with parents and families as soon as it becomes available from the school and/or state.</p>

<b>Curriculum</b>	La Escuela Primaria George Washington Carver utiliza un plan de estudios de alta calidad que apoya el éxito de los estudiantes. El personal de la escuela distribuirá información sobre nuestro plan de estudios, las formas de evaluación utilizadas para medir el progreso y el nivel de competencia que se espera que alcancen los estudiantes a través de folletos, conferencias de padres y maestros, reuniones y boletines informativos.
<b>Formas de Evaluaciones Académicas</b>	En la Escuela Primaria George Washington Carver, todos los maestros administran evaluaciones formativas comunes. Independientemente del maestro, cada estudiante es evaluado utilizando la misma evaluación proporcionada por el Sistema de Recursos TEKS, que se alinea con el formato de la prueba de Evaluaciones de Preparación Académica del Estado de Texas (STAAR).
	Además de las pruebas de responsabilidad estatal, las pruebas STAAR publicadas se utilizan tanto para la evaluación como para la instrucción. Estas pruebas son esenciales para evaluar el rendimiento de los estudiantes y tomar decisiones informadas sobre la instrucción.
	La información de los exámenes, incluidos los resultados de TELPAS y STAAR, se compartirá con los padres y las familias tan pronto como esté disponible en la escuela y/o el estado.
