- 8. Attend ALL concerts.

IMPORTANT STUFF! Grading Policy

60% Major Grades include, but are not limited to: tests, required rehearsals, concert attendance

30% Daily Grades include, but are not limited to, sight-reading, theory worksheets, and **DAILY** class participation.

10% Class Quizzes

All concerts/performances are graded assignments and are **required**.

All choir members are expected to attend all performances, required rehearsals and choir-related functions for the duration of the function. That means, you do not sing and leave...all will wait until the end of the performance to be dismissed.

In the event of an absence from a concert...

Students will sing their part before or after school for a maximum grade of 80 to make up their concert grade. Excused absences include family emergencies or severe illness. Unexcused absences include staying home, transportation issues (student doesn't have a ride), etc. Dates are placed on the calendar from the first day of school so that plans can be made in advance for attendance. Unexcused absences will be assigned a zero.

Your child has made a commitment to this program. Please help to foster correct and ethical behaviors in regards to absences. Everyone has put in the time and effort to be successful. Everyone matters!

In addition, punctuality is of vital importance to the choir program, so please be on time. The call time is when students need to be in their seats. If for some reason a parent or guardian is unable to attend a concert please pick up your child in a timely manner. This also should be adhered to for ALL practices as well.

What does "eligible" mean? No Pass - No Play

Lack of eligibility is the chief factor in an organization's success or failure. What does this mean? You must pass all of your classes with a 70 or above to participate in all EXTRA-curricular events. Grades matter! Stay current on class work, homework and missed assignments...This is VERY important!
