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<b>Forms of Academic Assessments</b>	<p>Horace Mann Junior School has Common Formative Assessments (CFA's) and Common Unit Assessments (CUA's) that every teacher gives. No matter the teacher, each child is assessed via the same assessment provided by TEKS Resource System which models each assessment after the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR).</p>
	<p>Test information, including STAAR, TELPAS, NWEA Maps, and other district assessments, will be shared with parents when available by the school/state.</p>
