Day 1 (Principal and Admin Team)

Incoming Freshmen will have the opportunity to ask questions about what life is really like at IMPACT and Lee College and find out tips and tricks for student success.

Breakout sessions

1. Scavenger Hunt (Teachers)

Becoming familiar with IMPACT locations and traditions is an important part of feeling at home at IMPACT. Teachers will take students on a scavenger hunt of important IMPACT locations.

- Foam Block activity Collaboration (Teachers)
 Collaboration and communication are key elements to student success, both at IMPACT and Lee College.
 Teachers will take students through an exciting collaborative activity using foam blocks.
- Wellness (Counselor & SWI)
 It is important for dual credit high schools students (and well, everybody, really) to practice self-care techniques. Counselor/SWI will provide ideas and opportunities for student wellness.
- Lee College Application (Counselors) Counselors will take students through the process to complete APPLY TEXAS and the Lee College Application. Students will finish their applications in this session.
- College 101 (Teachers) IMPACT AND Lee College Dual Credit instructor Teachers will present keys to student success at Lee College.
- 6. Reading Roundup (Teachers) Summer is for reading books that you want to read! Teachers will discuss the importance of reading in all subject areas and conduct a "Build your stack" activity. Students will be given the opportunity to check out a book from the IMPACT classroom library or the Book Pop Up at lunch.
- AVID Something (Teachers)
 All Freshmen at IMPACT take AVID, and Teachers will provide an engaging activity using AVID strategies.
- Campus Connections Service (Teachers)
 Service to our school and community is part of the fabric of IMPACT, and Teachers will provide an overview of club and activities available to IMPACT students.
- High School 101 (Counselor)
 High School Counselor will talk review important information about the Freshman year (and all years) at IMPACT.
