

Parking privileges are available to Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors by completing this form.

- 1. Seniors, Juniors, and Sophomores may park in the IMPACT student parking area adjacent to the Lee H.S. Baseball Field.
- 2. Park only in the student parking areas.
- 3. A student driving an automobile to school will be required to have a valid Texas driver's license, proof of liability insurance and a parking permit **properly displayed on the dashboard.**
- 4. A STUDENT WILL RECEIVE ONE PARKING PERMIT FOR ONE VEHICLE ONLY. Permits are not transferable between vehicles.
- 5. <u>All cars on campus must have a parking permit.</u> Failure to comply with these rules will result in Parking Violations and Consequences. They are as follows:

1st Violation - Conduct Report/Warning

- 2^{nd} Violation Loss of Permit for 2 weeks. (If a student is observed driving on campus during a <u>Loss of Permit</u> for either a 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} violation, this will result in losing the permit for the entire school year.
- <u>3rd Violation</u> Car will be <u>"booted"</u> and student will be charged a <u>\$25.00 (cash only)</u> fee in addition to Loss of Permit for the Semester.
- 4th Violation Car will be <u>"booted"</u> and student will be charged a **\$25.00 (cash only)** fee in addition to Loss of Permit for the remainder of the year.

Students who do not purchase a permit will be given TWO WARNINGS; subsequent violations will result in the car being "booted" and student charged a \$25.00 (cash only) fee.

ALL "BOOTED" VEHICLES MUST BE PAID BY 3:30 P.M., OR VEHICLE WILL REMAIN "BOOTED" TILL THE NEXT SCHOOL DAY.

- Students who bring cars on campus need to fully understand the district drug/alcohol policy as it pertains to the searching of automobiles. Students who park on GCCISD property are subject to random drug testing.
- If a student transfers a permit to another student or possesses another student's permit, it will be considered as giving false information. This may result in a conduct report and forfeiture of parking privileges.
- Students will not be permitted to sit in parked automobiles or congregate in the parking area at any time. This includes before school, during lunch, or after school.
- Students are not permitted in the parking lot at any time unless they have permission from a campus administrator.
- Students are not to park in spaces reserved for staff members.
- Observe 10 M.P.H. speed limit at all times on GCCISD parking lot property.
- Students who use their vehicles to leave campus without permission or transport students off campus who do not have permission may lose their privilege to park on campus.
- Parking permits give students the privilege of parking in the assigned parking areas if <u>all</u> rules and regulations concerning automobile traffic are obeyed. Students who cannot or will not abide by these rules may lose the right to bring their vehicle on campus.
- Students who park on the Lee College campus must also obtain a Lee College parking pass.
