GOOSE CREEK CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT and all its campuses received a rating of Met Standard from the Texas Education Agency (TEA) in 2018. This is the highest rating given by TEA. GCCISD is in Baytown, in Harris and Chambers Counties. Baytown is located 30 miles east of Houston and is home to Exxon, Chevron, and Bayer Chemical Facilities and encompasses 134 square miles. GCCISD serves a diverse population of more than 77,000 citizens. GCCISD includes 28 schools with an approximate student enrollment of 23,388.

GOOSE CREEK MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL is the third comprehensive high school campus in GCCISD founded in 2008. GCM is a public four-year high school with an enrollment of 2,163 students. Of this total, 541 students are freshman, 528 are sophomores, 552 are juniors, and 542 are seniors. Our ethnic diversity is 2.54% Asian, 18.49% African American, 57.86% Hispanic, 18.99% Caucasian, 1.89% two or more races. The percentage of economically disadvantaged student is 49%.

THE CURRICULUM consists of almost 300 courses for students to choose from to prepare themselves for college, to attend a university, technical school, or a career. Courses are offered at a regular level as well as an advanced level. Pre-Advanced Placement, Advanced Academic and Dual Credit courses are advanced level classes that provide students more concentrated study in a particular field. Courses are currently taught on an 8-period day and numeric grades are awarded.

RANK IN CLASS

Class rank shall be determined by a student's academic class rank (ACR). The ACR shall be determined by dividing accumulated grade points earned by the total number of state-approved foundation courses, Advanced Placement, and dual credit courses taken. GCCISD uses a weighted 5.0 GPA. Students shall earn an additional 0.5 grade point for each course in which the student takes the associated AP exam and scores a 3, 4, or 5. Final class rank for graduating seniors shall be assessed after the 30th week of the school year.
