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GOOSE CREEK CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT is located in Baytown, Texas, in Harris and Chambers Counties. GCCISD serves a diverse population of more than 77,000 citizens. GCCISD includes 32 schools with an approximate student enrollment of 24,000.

GOOSE CREEK MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL, founded in 2008, is the third comprehensive high school campus in GCCISD. GCM is a public four-year high school with an enrollment of 2,102 students. Of this total, 486 students are freshmen, 519 are sophomores, 585 are juniors, and 512 are seniors. The ethnic diversity is 2.56% Asian, .05% Pacific Islander, 17.37% African American, 64.5% Hispanic, 12.77% Caucasian, 2.66% two or more races. The percentage of economically disadvantaged students is 69%.

In 2024-25, Goose Creek Memorial High School received a rating from the Texas Educational Agency of 86, with a sub-score of 98% in college, career, and military readiness. Courses are currently taught on a 7-period day and numerical grades are awarded. Courses are offered at a regular level as well as an advanced level. Honors, Advanced Placement, On Ramps, and dual credit courses offer an advanced level curriculum which provides students with a more concentrated study to attend a college, university, technical school, or become workforce ready. GCM has the largest dual credit enrollment in GCCISD with approximately 2700 seats. Along with dual credit, GCM offers 16 AP courses with students performing at a 66% overall passing rate, with an 81% passing rate in math subjects. The Global Business Academy was named a National Model Business Academy by the National Academy Coalition. Goose Creek Memorial High School also runs a National Demonstration School AVID program.
