



Homeschooled, Independent Study, and Virtual School Students and Students from Other Schools

In our descriptions of virtual schools, virtual schools are those that exclusively offer online learning; this does not include schools that may be offering distance learning this year in response to the ongoing pandemic. Similarly, “homeschooled students” are those who regularly and exclusively learn through a designated homeschool; this does not apply to students whose classes at their public or private school are being offered remotely due to the pandemic.
