## *The Distinguished Level of Achievement (DLA)*

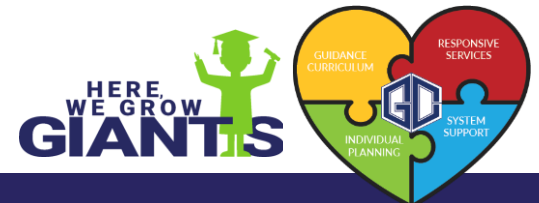
A student may earn a distinguished level of achievement by successfully completing:

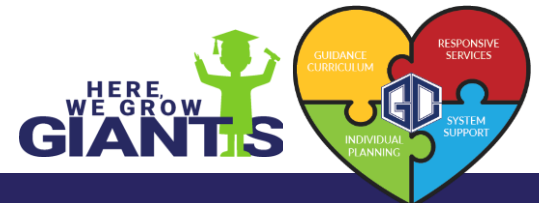

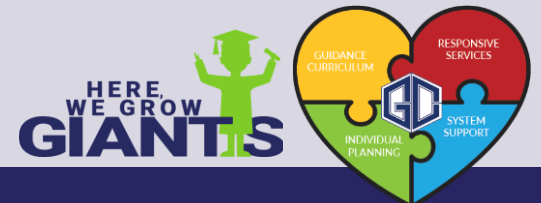
**Naviance** - An online platform that helps students , beginning in grade 6 , to navigate post- secondary planning. This includes many personal assessments and there is a parent/guardian component that we will discuss in November.

To sign in - Google Naviance, Go to Student / Parent . Use student id # instead of email address and 8 digit DOB as password. DD/MM/YYYY



Apply Texas is an online college application system that a student can apply once and then copy their application to other Texas public institution of higher learning. This saves time and it is FREE!

At PEH all seniors apply to Lee College and get free TSIA testing on PEH campus instead of paying to at the college for the test. Results can be sent to other colleges.



# TESTS

**TSIA** - Offered at PEH , NO COST

**ACT-** Seniors will get voucher and choose their own dates individually

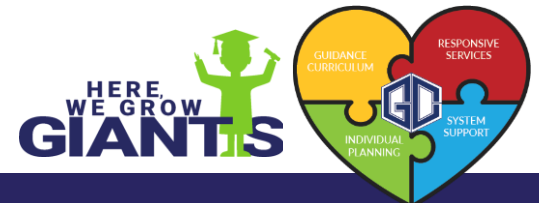
**SAT** - Vouchers if student is eligible for Free or Reduced lunch

**ASVAB** - Depends on Covid 19. May be able to offer it later.





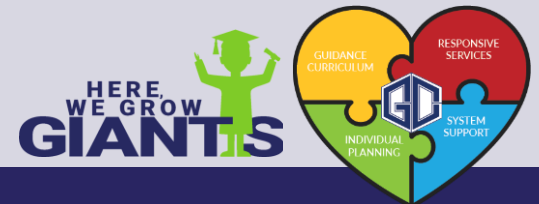
Texas Success Initiative Assessment determines college readiness. When students earn certain scores in reading, writing, and math they can skip remedial college classes and go directly to college level classes. This saves them time and money.



# ACT<sup>®</sup>

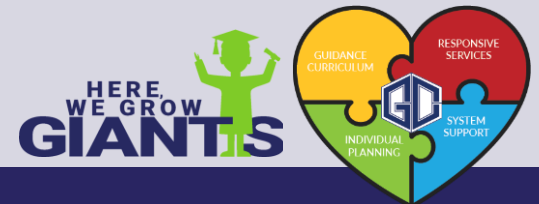
State of Texas requires ACT testing in spring of the Junior year but due to Covid 19 it was cancelled in Spring 2020. To replace that free testing opportunity we are now offering students vouchers and they may choose an ACT date of their individual choice.

Vouchers are forthcoming .





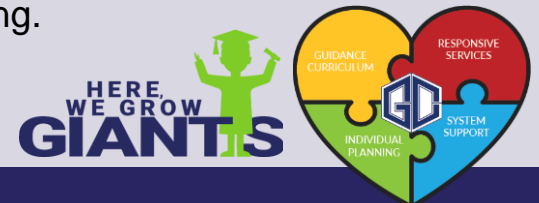

### ASVAB Testing

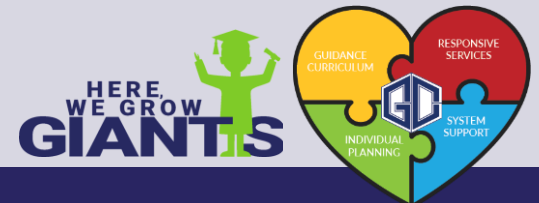
We hope to offer this later in the year .

Character Strong is designed to support Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) & Character Education.

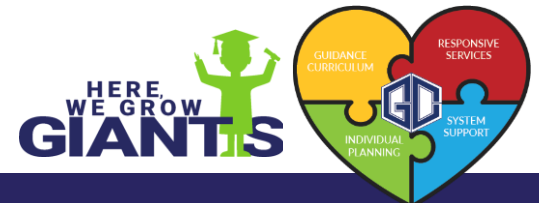
